GRANT APPLICATION

Young Adult Steering Initiative (YASI) is accepting proposals of up to \$530 (which is equal to 16 cases of diapers) per grant cycle. There are six (6) grant cycles per year. Applicants can only receive one grant award per year; there is no limit to the number of applications submitted per year. Following the award decisions, those not selected will also be notified.

The 2016 award dates are **March 22, May 24, July 19, September 20 and January 24, 2017**. Applications should be postmarked or emailed one month prior to the posted award dates.
